

To have and to hold the aforesigned premises to the said Fenner Wilcox his heirs and assigns to his and their use and behoof forever except said thirds, and I do for mysel my heirs executors and administrators covenant with the said Fenner Wilcox his heirs and assigns that I am lawfully seized in fee of the aforesigned premises: that they are free of all incumbrances, except said Deborah Southwick thirds. That I have good right to sell and convey the same to the said Fenner Wilcox and that I will and my heirs shall warrant and defend the same premises to the said Fenner Wilcox his, except as above, heirs and assigns forever against the lawful claims and demands of all persons, and wife of the said, for the consideration aforesaid do hereby release and quitclaim unto the said heirs and assigns all the right title claim or demand which may have in and unto the premises hereby conveyed under or by virtue of the homestead exemption laws of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts and also all right claim or possibility of dower in said premises. In witness whereof I the said Elvira D. Southwick have hereunto set my hand and seal this nineteenth day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty eight.
