Know all men by these presents that I, Mary S. Munyon of Mendon, County of Worcester and Common-wealth of Massachusetts in consideration of One dollar and other valuable considerations paid by Hattie M. Spredbury of Whitefield, in the State of New Hampshire, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby give, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Hattie M. Spredbury, a certain piece of land situated in the Easterly part of said Mendon on the Easterly side of the road leading from the residence of Joseph Bates to Bellington, containing twelve acres, more or less, with the buildings thereon, bounded and described as follows, viz: Beginning at the Northwesterly corner of the premises at a corner of land late of Eliza Jackson and at said road; thence running Southerly by said road twenty eight rods and twelve links to a wall at land of heirs of John Howe; thence as said wall stands S. 73 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° E. 52 rods 5 links to a corner of wall; thence N. 20° W. 40 rods 20 links; thence N. 28 $\frac{3}{4}$ ° W. 26 rods 14 links; thence S. 55 $\frac{1}{3}$ ° W. 33 rods 19 links to the place of beginning. Being bounded Northerly partly by land late of Eliza Jackson and partly by land of Joseph Bates; Easterly by land of said Bates; Southerly by land of heirs of John Howe and Westerly by said road, with the right of way over the Southeast corner of the premises owned by Fotham Howard, his heirs and assigns excepted. It being the same premises described in deed of Mary A. Webber to me dated December 1<sup>st</sup> 1894, and recorded with Worcester District Deeds, libro 1462, folio 190, and this conveyance is made subject to a mortgage on the premises to Gustavus B. Williams to secure a note for \$800 and interest from May 20<sup>a</sup> 1897, which grantee is to assume and pay as a part of the consideration for this conveyance.
