Said premises are conveyed subject to the following restrictions:-That all buildings shall be placed and set back not less than twenty-five (25) feet from the street line, providing that steps, windows, porticoes and other projections appurtenant thereto are to be allowed in said space; that no house with a flat roof nor to accommodate more than two families shall be built upon said premises; that no building known as a "three decker" shall be built upon said premises; that no one family house erected thereon shall cost less than thirty-five hundred dollars (\$3500.00) and no two family house erected thereon shall cost less than seven thousand dollars (\$7000.00); that no public garage shall be built on said premises; that no garage or outbuilding shall be erected thereon nearer than sixty-five (65) feet to the street line, nor to accommodate more than four automobiles and to be used only for private purposes; that no building shall be erected for manufacturing or business purposes.

Said premises are also conveyed subject to the right to lay or run a drain through said land with the right to enter upon said premises to lay or run said drain pipe and for the purpose of keeping said drain pipe in repair; as set forth in said deed to grantor herein conveying said parcel. The above premises are conveyed subject to the agreement on the part of the grantee to pay for the cost of installing a sewer and building a sidewalk in front of the above described premises, which covenant is set forth in the aforesaid deed to the grantor herein conveying said premises, which covenant the grantee herein agrees to assume and save the grantor harmless from.
