A certain tract or parcel of land situated on the easterly side of Bates Street in said Mendon and being more particularly bounded and described as follows, to wit:-

Beginning at a drill hole in the intersection of stone walls at the northwesterly corner of the granted premises at said Street and at land of one Townsend, thence S. 82° 44' E. by a stone wall and said Townsend land 150 feet to a drill hole in said wall; thence S. 15° 30' E. by remaining portion of the grantors premises 100 feet to a stake; thence N. 82° 44' W. by remaining portion of the grantors premises 151.8 feet to a drill hole in a stone wall in the easterly line of said Street; thence N. 15° 30' W. by the easterly line of said Street 100 feet to the drill hole at the point of beginning.
