Also a certain tract of pasture and wood land said tracts of land being the same premises conveyed by deed from Elias P. Bicknell to said Laban Adams dated August 20th A.D. 1870 recorded with Worcester Registry of Deeds Book 827 Page 520 to which reference may be had for a more particular description of said premises. To have and to hold the above granted premises with all the privileges and appurtenances to the same belonging to the said Taft his heirs and assigns to their own use and behoof forever. And I the said grantor for myself and my heirs executors and administrators do covenant with the said grantee and his heirs and assigns that I am lawfully seized in fee simple of the aforesaid premises that they are free from all incumbrances, that I have good right to sell and convey the same to the said grantee and his heirs and assigns forever as aforesaid and that I will and my heirs executors and administrators shall warrant and defend the same to the said grantee and his heirs and assigns forever against the lawful claims and demands of all persons.
