 to Spalding of Mendon State of Massachusetts in considera-
 James R. Davis tion of Two Thousand Dollars paid by James R. Davis of Mil-
 ford, State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged,
 do hereby give, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said James
 R. Davis his heirs & assigns, a certain tract or parcel of land, con-
 taining one & three fourths acres and thirty six rods, situated
 in the North easterly part of said Mendon on the Easterly side
 of the road leading from South Milford to Womackett, with
 all the buildings standing theron. It being the same and
 all the same premises conveyed to me by deed of Amariah A.
 Taft dated November 19. A.D. 1872, & recorded with the Deeds of
 Worcester County, Lib. 886, Fol. 422. And more fully described
 in a deed from Elias P. Picknell to Leaban Adams dated August
 20th A.D. 1870 & recorded with Worcester County Deeds Book 827, Page
 526, & is the first lot described in said deed.
 To have
 and to hold the granted premises, with all the privileges and
 appurtenances thereto belonging, to the said James R. Davis and
 his heirs and assigns to their own use and behoof forever. And I hereby
 for myself and my heirs, executors and administrators covenant
 with the grantee and his heirs and assigns that I am lawfully
 seized in fee-simple of the granted premises, that they are free
 from all incumbrances, that I have good right to sell and con-
 vey the same as aforesaid: and that I will and my heirs, executors
 and administrators shall warrant and defend the same to
 the grantee and his heirs and assigns forever against the
 lawful claims and demands of all persons.

 hand and seal this Thirtieth day of March in the year one
 thousand eight hundred and eighty seven.
