Said premises are subject to a prior mortgage to the Milford Savings Bank in the amount of \$1,000.

Davenport, administratrix of the estate of Luther E. Taft, to me, by deed dated September 4, 1917, recorded with Worcester District Deeds, book 2143, page 405."
