The land in the Town of Mendon, County of Worcester, Commonwealth of Massachusetts, bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the north side of the highway called Park Street, said point being the southeast corner of a cemetery, known as the 'Daniels Cemetery'; thence northerly at right angles to said Park Street in a line parallel to said cemetery 150 feet to a point; thence easterly in a line parallel to said street 150 feet to a point; thence southerly parallel to the first line 150 feet to the north side of said Park Street; thence westerly along the northerly side of said Park Street 150 feet to the point of beginning. Containing about 0.52 of an acre.
