A certain tract or parcel of land, with the buildings thereon, situated in said Mendon, and bounded and described as follows, to wit:-

Beginning at a point on the north side of the highway called Park Street, said point being the southeast corner of a cemetery, known as the "Daniels Cemetery"; thence northerly at right angles to said Park Street in a line parallel to said cemetery 150 feet to a point; thence easterly in a line parallel to said street 150 feet to a point; thence southerly parallel to the first line 150 feet to the north side of said Park Street; thence westerly along the northerly side of said Park Street 150 feet to the point of beginning. Containing about 0.52 of an acre.

Meaning and intending to convey and hereby conveying the same and all the same premises as were conveyed to me by deed of Arthur Wiersma et alii, dated May 22, 1950, and recorded with Worcester District Deeds, Book 3257, Page 40.
