and assigns that the premises are free from all incumbrances
made or suffered by me except as aforesaid and that I will and
my heirs executors and administrators shall warrant and defend
the same to the said Day and his heirs and assigns forever
against the lawful claims and demands of all persons claiming by
through, or under me except as aforesaid, but against none other.

unto the said Laban and Elias T Bates their heirs and assigns a
small tract of wood and sprout land situated in the westerly part of
Bellingham containing cisteen acres three quarters thirteen rods be
the same more or less and bounded as follows viz beginning at the
westerly corner of the premises by land of said Laban Bates and
other lands of said grantor running S. 88° E. thirty nine rods and
sixteen links by my other lands to a stone wall thence south 81° west
thirty four rods thence south 13 1/2° west eighteen rods and four links
thence due south two rods and eight links to a stake and stones and
bounded easterly by my other lands thence north 88° west forty two
rods and five links by land of Willard Chilson and Isaac Davis to a
stake and stones thence north 72° east eleven rods and two links to
the wall now stands to a stake at the end thereof thence north 28° east
