To have and to hold the above granted premises with the
privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging to the said
Robert Cook his heirs and assigns to him & their use
and behoof forever. and we the said Gardius & Clara Skinner
for ourselves and our heirs executors and administrators
do covenant with the said Robert Cook his heirs and
assigns that we are lawfully seized in fee of the aforesigned
premises. that they are free from all incumbrances.

Provided nevertheless that if the said Gardius &
Clara Skinner their heirs executors or administrators shall
pay unto the said Robert Cook his heirs executors adminis-
trators or assigns the sum of three hundred dollars in manner
following viz. as by his note of this date for value rec'd
promised to pay Robert Cook or his order the above sum of
three hundred dollars in six annual payments of fifty
dollars with annual interest from the 1st day of April next
then this deed as also said note bearing even date with
these presents signed by the said Gardius Skinner whereby
promised to pay to the said Robert Cook the said sum and interest
at the time and in the manner aforesaid shall be absolutely
void to all intents and purposes. but until default shall
be made in the payment of said sum or some part thereof
or of the interest therefor the said executors administrators
or assigns shall have no right to take possession of the afore-
granted premises. In witness whereof we the said Gardius
& Clara Skinner have hereunto set our hands and seals
this twenty fifth day of March in the year of our Lord one
thousand eight hundred and fifty eight.
