

Meaning and intending to convey and hereby conveying the same and all the same premises as were conveyed to us by deed of Austin B. Taft, dated January 5, 1909 and recorded with said Deeds, Book 1895, Page 403, so far as the same are now in force and applicable and also subject to any rights of the American Telephone and Telegraph Company or the New England Telephone and Telegraph Company to construct, operate and maintain its lines over the granted premises, if any such now exist.

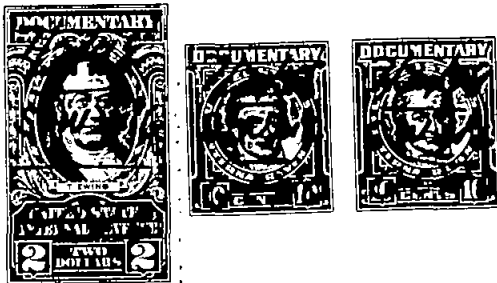
SECOND PARCEL:-
