of four thousand ~~and~~ nine hundred dollars paid by Sim-
on Thornton of Smithfield in the County of Providence
and State of Rhode Island and Providence Plantations,
Yeoman, the Receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge, do
hereby give, grant, grant sell and convey unto the said Simon
Thornton his heirs and assigns, three certain tracts or parcels
of land situate in said Mendon. The first piece being the home-
stead lately owned by Capt. Isaac Mowry late deceased con-
taining ninety five acres and one hundred twenty three rods,
more or less, bounded as follows, viz. beginning at a rock in the
brook, a corner of Obediah Woods land, being the north west cor-
ner of the premises running down the centre of said brook
25 rods to the centre of a large rock in the wall, said Woods
corner, thence west $3\frac{2}{3}$ south $13\frac{1}{4}$ rods to stones at the corner
of wall by Henry Mowry's land, said Woods corner, thence
south $4\frac{1}{2}$ east 10 rods to a maple tree on the south side of
