Shattuck, Easterly by Cben & Rice Esq^r & Stephen Doane and South erly by James Hamilton, and also of a third tract, being part of House lot No 30, containing thirty acres more or less, and is bounded Northwest erly by a town way, Easterly by land of Haskell Freeman, Southerly & Easterly by land of William King, with all the privileges and appurte nances thereto belonging.

To have and to hold the same to the said Cleaver James, his heirs and assigns, to his and their use and behoof forever. And I do covenant to warrant and defend, the said granted and quitclaimed premises to the said Cleaver James, his heirs and assigns forever, against the lawful claims and demands of all persons, claiming by or under me excepting the said Gilbert Deane, his heirs and assigns.
