eight hundred dollars to me paid by Samuel Hilliard
of Milford in said County Gentleman the receipt whereof
I do hereby acknowledge do give grant sell and convey unto
the said Samuel Hilliard his heirs and assigns a certain tract
or parcel of land in said Mendon with the buildings thereon
near where the old Parish meeting house formerly stood
on the westerly side of the road leading by the house of
the late Warren Ransoms Esq bounded easterly on said road
& westerly on lands of the late C. C. P. Hastings & Mary M
Hayward - northerly on the late Warren Ransom's office lot
& one rods from the southerly end of said office and south-
erly on lands of Ezekiel Fletcher to ^{the} north end of said
Fletcher's house containing about forty rods more or less and
being the same lot of land purchased by Ezra Seland of
Marcia Stone and purchased by said Stone of Daniel Raw-
son by his deed recorded in the Registry of Deeds for said
County Book 388 page 605 and being the same premises that
were conveyed to me by Hiram A. Stone by deed dated Oct 16
1849 and recorded in said Registry Book 452 page 631
to which reference may be had.

To have and to
hold the aforesigned premises to the said Samuel Hilliard
his heirs and assigns to his and their use and behoof forever
And I do for myself my heirs executors and administrators
covenant with the said Hilliard his heirs and assigns
that I am lawfully seized in fee of the aforesigned
premises that they are free of all incumbrances except a
mortgage deed to Daniel Ransom dated April 1-1846
for the sum of five hundred & fifty dollars & interest
which said Hilliard is to pay that I have good right to
