Willm Paylesdg. Know all men by these presents, that we Payles Willm  
to  
and Ruth Willm wife of the said Payles Willm both of  
Royal M<sup>r</sup>. Wheelock the City and County of Providence and State of Rhode  
Island for and in consideration of the sum of one  
hundred and fifty dollars to us paid by Royal M<sup>r</sup>.  
Wheelock of Kendon in the County of Worcester in  
the State of Massachusetts, the receipt whereof is hereby  
acknowledged do hereby give grant bargain sell and  
convey unto him the said Royal M<sup>r</sup>. Wheelock his  
heirs and assigns all the right title interest & prop-  
erty which we the said Grantors or which either  
of us have as heirs at law of Elijah Taft late of said  
Kendon deceased is and to a certain tract or par-  
cel of woodland lying and being in said Kendon  
containing by estimation five acres and sixteen  
rods bounded as follows viz. beginning at the North-  
east corner of said land at stake in the swamp, then  
South 14° East & bounded Easterly by Thomas Taft's land  
forty six rods to a stake in the pine swamp being the  
South east corner, then West 16° South and bounded  
Southerly by land now or formerly owned by Daniel  
Day twenty rods to a stake at Jesse Townlett's land being  
the North west corner, thence North 14 $\frac{1}{2}$  - Westerly  
by said Townlett's land twenty six and three quarter  
rods to a heap of stones, thence East 70° North & bound-  
ed Northerly by Alvan Taft's land two rods to a heap  
of stones, then North 14 $\frac{1}{2}$  - West & bounded Westerly  
by the said Alvan Taft's land about nineteen rods  
and a half to a stake and stones at Nathaniel Taft's  
land being the North west corner, thence East 24-  
North and bounded Northerly by said Nathaniel  
Taft's land sixteen and a half rods to the first  
bound or however otherwise the same may be  
bounded or described, it is the same lot of land
