


Know all men by these presents, that I, William G. Gassett of Mendon in the County of Worcester & Commonwealth aforesaid, Boot maker, in consideration of two hundred dollars paid by Gilbert Gaskill of Mendon in the County of Worcester and Commonwealth aforesaid, Yeoman, the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge, do give, grant, sell and convey unto the said Gilbert Gaskill, his heirs and assigns a certain parcel of land situated in Mendon near where the old meeting house lately stood and on the Westerly side of the road leading by said Gilbert Gaskill's bounded Easterly on said road; Westerly on land formerly belonging to Charles C. P. Hastings and his sister Mary Hayward; Northerly formerly on Col. Warren Rawson's office lot about one rod from the Southerly end of said office and Southerly on land formerly belonging to Ezekiah Fletcher to the North end of the house that formerly belonged to said Fletcher containing about forty rods; more or less with the dwelling house and wood house thereon with the privileges and appurtenances thereunto belonging. To have and to hold the afore granted premises to the said Gilbert Gaskill, his heirs and assigns to his and their use and behoof forever. And I do for myself, my heirs, executors and administrators, covenant with the said Gilbert Gaskill, his heirs and assigns, that I am lawfully seized in fee of the afore granted premises: that they are free of all incumbrances: that I have good right to sell and convey the same to the said Gilbert Gaskill, and that I will warrant and defend the same to the said Gilbert Gaskill, his heirs and
