Massachusetts in consideration of thirty five hundred
dollars paid by William G. Gilbert of said Warren the
receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged do hereby give
grant bargain sell and convey unto the said William G.
Gilbert his heirs and assigns a certain tract of land
with the buildings thereon standing situate in Warren
aforesaid and described as follows viz: Commencing
at the Southwest corner of farm about to be described
at land of Lester Blodget's land: thence by land of Jos.
Ramsdell Jr. N. 21° W. thirty one rods and sixteen links to
a chestnut stump including the road five rods and two
links in width: thence still by land of Jos. Ramsdell Jr. N.
27½° W. one hundred twenty nine rods & fifteen links to stone
on the hill including the new road four rods & thirteen
links in width: thence still by land of said Ramsdell N. 8½°
W. one hundred rods & four links to a stake: thence N. 72° E
fifty five rods and nineteen links to land of Reuben Reed
thence by land of said Reed S. 24° E. twenty four rods & four
links to the end of a wall: thence still by land of
said Reed S. 53½° E. thirty six rods & twenty three links to
land of Nathan Reed: thence by land of said Nathan
S. 22° W. twenty six rods & four links to a heap of stones on
a rock: thence still by land of said Nathan S. 42° E. one
hundred thirty seven rods to a heap of stones at the
Southeast corner of the farm being described including
the road three rods in width: thence still by land of said
