interest and estate in and unto any and all the estate
of Eli Hewett late of Northbridge deceased and any and
all the right and interest to the reversionary right in
the thirds of the Meadow of said deceased after her decease.
meaning and intending hereby to convey all the right
and interest I have as one of the heirs to the estate of
said Eli Hewett. To have and to hold the same
to the said Valentine L. Hewett his heirs and assigns to
his and their use and behoof forever and I do covenant
to warrant and defend said granted and quitclaimed
premises to the said Valentine L. Hewett his heirs and as-
signs forever against the lawful claims and demands of
all persons claiming by or under me. And I Maria H. He-
wett wife of the said Wilcome W. Hewett for the consideration
aforesaid do relinquish to said V. L. Hewett his heirs and as-
signs all the right title claim or demand which I may
have in and unto the premises hereby conveyed under or
by virtue of the homestead exemption laws of the Common-
wealth of Massachusetts and also all right claim or possi-
bility of dower in said premises. In witness where-

have hereunto set our hands and seals this first day of
Feb. in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred
and fifty eight.
