grant bargain sell and convey unto the said Lewis Stone  
2<sup>d</sup> his heirs and assigns a certain tract of land with all  
the buildings thereon formerly known as the Capt. Holden  
place and bounded as follows viz: Beginning at a point  
upon the Westerly side of the road leading from the County  
road opposite the house of Nathan George to the house  
where the grantor now lives at a corner at land of Wil-  
liam Gassett thence southerly by and with the first  
mentioned road to a corner of wall at other land of  
grantor thence turning and running Westerly as the  
wall now stands to a corner at land of Nathan George  
thence turning and running Northerly as the wall  
now stands to a corner at land of William Gassett  
thence turning and running Easterly and bounded  
Northerly by land of William Gassett to the place of  
beginning.

To have and to hold the  
above granted premises with the privileges and appurte-
