To have and to hold the same to the said James J. Suss and Lorin Eddy and their heirs and assigns to them and their use and behoof forever. But this release shall in no possible event or contingency be deemed or held to affect or impair the right of the said Richard Barker, to hold all the remainder of the parcel of land conveyed in said mortgage deed, and not hereby released, as security for the sum still remaining due upon said mortgage.

Thayer of said Mendon, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby sell, convey, remise, release and forever quitclaim unto the said Albert H. Thayer, all my right, title, claim, interest and demands which I have or can have as guardian of the curtesy or otherwise in and to a certain tract or parcel of land and farm, and the buildings thereon, situate in the southerly part of said Mendon on both sides of the road leading from said Mendon to Blackstone, and called the "Lamb Swamp Road" and bounding Northerly on lands of Owen Cunningham, land of Olive and Mary Howard and land of A. W. Judson; Easterly on land of said Judson and land of Nathaniel A. Inman; Southerly on land of said Inman, and Westerly on land of William Wood and land of Carlton Staples; being the land and farm of Alice Thayer, my wife, lately deceased, and the farm she purchased of one George Staples; and the said
