

Taft land; thence with wall or walls by land of said Eliza-
beth Taft land of Austin A. Taft and land formerly of Thomas
Gardner to said road; thence Easterly with said road to the
point of beginning. It being the same and all the same
land conveyed to me by four deeds to wit: Deed of Thomas
Gardner dated November 13, 1846, recorded in Worcester County
Registry of Deed Book 381 Page 653. Deed of same dated April
4th A.D. 1846, recorded in said Registry Book 430 Page 511, Deed of
Amariah A. Taft dated April 30, A.D. 1870, recorded in said Reg-
istry Book 833 Page 159 and deed of same dated July 2^d 1877 re-
corded in said Registry Book 1023 Page 515. The above is conveyed
subject to two mortgages made by me; the first to Josiah Fisher
dated January 21st 1862 recorded in said Registry Book 648 Page
115 on which is due \$600 and interest, the second to Samuel H.
Taft dated August 21st 1876 recorded in said Registry Book 996
Page 76 on which is due \$328 and interest which mortgages and
interest grantee is to assume and pay as a part of the consider-
ation aforesaid, and this conveyance is made subject to the
condition of his payment thereof.

To have and to
hold the granted premises, with all the privileges and ap-
purtainances thereto belonging, to the said Albert O. Darling
and his heirs and assigns, to their own use and behoof forever.
And I do hereby, for myself and my heirs, executors and ad-
ministrators covenant with the said grantee and his heirs,
and assigns that I am lawfully seized in fee simple of the
granted premises, that they are free from all incumbrances,
except the two mortgages aforesaid, that I have good right to
sell and convey the same as aforesaid; and that I will and
my heirs, executors, and administrators shall warrant and de-
fend the same to the said grantee and his heirs and assigns
forever against the lawful claims and demands of all per-
sons, except those claiming under the two mortgages aforesaid.

token of my release for the consideration aforesaid of dower and
homestead in the granted premises to said Albert O. Darling here-
