I, Clifton Q. Bates of Milford in the Commonwealth
of Massachusetts, in consideration of One dollar and
other valuable considerations paid by Robert J. Ferris
of Mendon in the Commonwealth aforesaid, the re-
ceipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby give
grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Robert
J. Ferris, a certain parcel of land containing about
one-fourth of an acre fenced and situated in the
central part of the town of Mendon on the Northerly
side of Blackstone Street, with a dwelling house there-
on, and bounded Northerly by land of J. A. George;
Easterly by land of one Gaseett; Southerly by said
street and Westerly by land of Gilbert Gaskill.
Also a second parcel separated from the first parcel
by said street containing about one-fourth of an acre
of fenced land bounded Northerly by said street, East-
erly by land of O. A. Snow; Southerly by the old ceme-
tery lot so called; and Westerly by land of Gilbert Gas-
kill, being land formerly owned by Andrew H. Judson
Being the same and all the same premises described
in a deed from Sarah C. Davenport, Executrix of will
of L. P. Cummings to Clifton Q. Bates dated November
29, 1898, and recorded with Worcester District Deeds Book
1594, Page 519. The above-described premises are conveyed
