Stowers, husband and wife, both - said Mendon, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby G I V E, G R A N T, B A R G A I N, S E L L and C O N - V E Y unto the said Carl B. Stowers and Carrie E. Stowers, certain premises, being all the same premises conveyed by Elmer I. Rhodes to me by deed dated September 14, 1907, recorded with Worcester District Deeds, Book 1862, Page 280, and bounded and described in said deed as follows, to wit:

"A certain tract or parcel of land containing about five acres, with a house, barn and other buildings thereon situated in said MENDON, on the westerly side of the road leading therefrom to Blackstone, through Dam Swamp, so-called; being in one lot enclosed on all sides, except the side on said road, by stone walls, and being bounded northerly by land of Harry C. Gaskill, westerly by land of Harriot E. Darling, southerly by land of one Hoberg, and easterly by said road."
