I, Rodney Dunbar, of Mendon, Worcester County, Massachusetts, being unmarried, for consideration paid, grant to Francis H. Dunbar and Rita M. Dunbar, husband and wife, as tenants by the entirety, of said Mendon, with warranty covenants the land in said Mendon, situated on the westerly side of Thornton Street, and bounded and described as follows:

Commencing at a bound at the southeasterly corner of the granted premises, on the westerly line of said Thornton Street, and thence running northwesterly by the westerly line of Thornton Street eighty (80) feet to a bound at other land of the grantor; thence southwesterly by grantor's said other land two hundred (200) feet to a bound; thence southerly by other land of the grantor eighty (80) feet to a bound at land now or formerly of one Rogers; thence northeasterly by said Rogers land two hundred (200) feet to the place of beginning.
