Fagan and Annie M. Fagan, by deed dated October 15, 1935, and recorded
in Worcester District Registry of Deeds, Book 2653, page 93, and bounded
and described in said deed as follows:-

" A certain tract or parcel of land containing about five acres,

the year 1950 which the grantee hereby assume and agree to pay
as part consideration for this deed.
