

Probate Court at Uxbridge May 25. 1813. -

Israel Mowry's Will.

In the name of God, Amen -
I Israel Mowry of Mendon in the County of Worcester and Commonwealth of Massachusetts, Yeoman, being weak of Body but of sound and perfect mind and memory, blessed be Almighty God for the same, do make and publish this my last Will and Testament, in manner and form following, that is to say, -

First, I give and bequeath unto my beloved Wife Patience Mowry the rents and profits of one third part of all the Real Estate that I've seized and possessed of during her natural life; this intended to be her third or dower that by law she would be entitled to, in case I had made no Will. - I also give and bequeath her all the Household furniture that she brought to me when we married. I also give her the Notes of hand that I hold against the following Persons Viz. - one against Stephen Wood of about two hundred & thirty Dollars, one against Baruch Pennington, one against James East, one against Joseph Arnold and one against James Arnold, with the Interest that may be due on each. - I also give her the sum of one hundred and thirty Dollars to be paid by my Executors here, after named, to be paid in one year after my decease. - I also give her my Horse, Chair and Harness likewise one of my silver table Spoons. -

I give and bequeath to my eldest Son Uthure Mowry my Buck Distich, so called, lying on the road leading from Doct. Joseph Adams in Mendon by Enos East; the same to be his share out of my Estate. -

I give and bequeath unto my second Son Gardner Mowry my silver Watch, it being all I intend to give him. -

I give and bequeath unto my four Sons Asaiah Mowry, Caleb Mowry, Israel Mowry and Robert Mowry, a 1/4 of my Real Estate wherever situated, not otherwise disposed of by this Will, together with the Wills that I have by this Will given to my Wife, after her decease the same to be equally divided between them. - I also give to my Son Arnold the Note of hand that I hold against Ebenezer East of about three hundred Dollars with the Interest that may be due thereon. - I also give my Son Robert the rifle gun that I bought of my Son Israel. -

Thereby give and bequeath unto my Daughter Alice Wood Wife of Chadrach Wood the sum of Sixty Dollars. -

I hereby give unto my Daughter Mary Rawson Wife of Grindal Rawson, the sum of Sixty Dollars. -
