To all People to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting,

I Know Ye, That I Thomas Sanford of Mendon in the County of Worcester and
in the Province of the Massachusetts Bay in New England yeman

For and in Consideration of the Sum of Three Pounds Lawfull money
to me in Hand before the Ensealing hereof, well and truly paid by Silas Wheelock of Mendon aforesaid
Husbandman

and my self therewith fully satisfied and contented; and thereof, and of every Part
and Parcel thereof, do exonerate, acquit and discharge him — the said Silas Wheelock
his Heirs, Executors and Administrators,
forever by these Presents: HAVE given, granted, bargained, sold, aliened, conveyed and
confirmed; and by these Presents, Do freely, fully and absolutely give, grant, bargain, sell,
aliene, convey and confirm, unto him the said Silas Wheelock

Mendon aforesaid Soil unto Lying and being on the Eastly Side of a hill Known by Name
of Caleb Hill containing by Estimation two acres be the same more or less it being a corner
of the Grantees Land partly Enclosed with the Grantees Land (a three Rod way running
through said Land, which wherein is Excepted as the said piece of Land is bounded beginning at a
heap of Stones on the north side of said way being the Grantees Southeast Corner therefrom running
with a direct line as before now stands Cross said way home to John Frenchs Land then turning
westly with said Frenchs Land home to the Grantees Corner on the south side said way
on all other parts on the Grantees own Land

To have and to Hold the said granted and bargained Premises, with all the
Appurtenances, Priviledges and Commodities to the same belonging, or in any wise apper-
taining to him — the said Silas Wheelock his
Heirs and Assigns for ever. To his and their only proper Use, Benefit and Behoof forever.
And for the said Thomas Sanford
Heirs, Executors and Administrators, do covenant, promise and grant to and with

him, the said Silas Wheelock his
Heirs and Assigns, that before the Ensealing hereof I am the true sole and lawful Owner of
the above-bargained Premises, and am lawfully seized and possessed of the same in my own
proper Right, as a good perfect and absolute Estate of Inheritance in Fee Simple: And have in
myself good Right, full Power and lawful Authority, to grant, bargain, sell, convey
and confirm, said bargained Premises in manner as aforesaid: And that the said Silas
Wheelock his Heirs and Assigns, shall and may
from Time to Time, and at all Times forever hereafter, by Force and Virtue of these Pre-
sents, lawfully, peaceably and quietly Have, Hold, Use, Occupy, Possess and Enjoy the said
demised and bargained Premises, with the Appurtenances, free and clear, and freely and
clearly acquitted, exonerated and discharged of, from all and all manner of former or other
Gifts, Grants, Bargains, Sales, Leases, Mortgages, Wills, Entails, Jointures, Dowries,
Judgments, Executions, or Incumbrances of what Name or Nature soever, that might in any
Measure or Degree obstruct or make void this present Deed.

Furthermore, The said Thomas Sanford

for my self my Heirs,
Executors and Administrators, do Covenant and Engage the above demised Premises to him
the said Silas Wheelock his Heirs and
Assigns, against the lawful Claims or Demands of any Person or Persons whatsoever, forever
hereafter to Warrant, Secure and Defend by these Presents. Dated Feby 1747/8
