Mendon April 7. 1814 a memorandum of an agreement made between Seth Wheelock & his Son Benjamin Wheelock both of said Mendon do mutually agree that Seth Chapin William Torrey & Elijah Thayer shall appraise and set off to said Benjamin one third part of his farm in Mendon aforesaid in quantity & quality which third part the said Seth Wheelock had given his Son Benjamin Wheelock by deed in common with himself in the above named met by the request of Seth Wheelock & Benjamin Wheelock and did appraise & set off one third part of Seth Wheelock's real estate which he had given the said Benjamin by deed as followeth beginning at a road in front of his dwelling House running North twenty & 1/2 deg. West through the House
