 remised, released, and forever quit claimed, and do, for our selfs and our
 heirs, by these presents, remise, release, and forever quit claim unto the
 said Lydia Mann her heirs and assigns, all the right, title, that we
 have in the real Estate lying and being in said Mendon, and in our hon-
 -ored mother's third or dower in the same that our Father Alfonzo
 Mann dyed deceased and possessed of — To have and to hold the aforesaid
 - owned premises, with all the privileges and appurtenances thereto belong-
 - ing, to her the said Lydia Mann to her heirs and assigns forever: so that
 neither we the said Anna, Mercy, and Catherine nor our heirs, or any
 other person or persons claiming from or under us, or them, or in the
 name, right or stead of us or them, shall or will, by any way or means,
 have, claim, or demand any right or title to the aforesaid premises, or
 their appurtenances, or to any part or parcel thereof, forever. In witness

 have hereunto set our hand and seal this twenty seventh day of
