Wheeler Thrope Know all men by these presents that I Throphobus Wheeler of Worcester in the County
to of Worcester Esq. in consideration of five hundred and thirty nine Dollars paid by
Wheeler & Green William E. Green of the same town of Worcester Esq. the receipt whereof I do hereby
acknowledge, do hereby give, grant, sell, and convey unto the said William E. Green
his heirs and assigns a certain parcel of Land situated in the easterly part of
said town of Worcester, near Shatis called the Black Lead Mine, meaning hereby
to convey all the Land, which was conveyed to me, my heirs and assigns by deed
from Nathan Heard, dated April 12. 1810 Recorded in Book 476 Page 83
conveyed to him before that time by Nathan Patch's Executors (excepting
and reserving therefrom half an acre of said Land nearest the mine
now open) the whole of said Land is bounded as follows, beginning at the
south west corner of the same and runs North 36° West eighty three rods
to the wall, thence North 47° East thirty seven rods wanting 18 links, then
South 51° East sixty two rods to a heap of stones near where an Oak tree
formerly stood, and near said mine now open, & worked - then South
10 1/2° East fourteen rods, then South 36° West forty eight rods as the
