I, THOMAS P. KELLEY  
 of Mendon Worcester County, Massachusetts,  
 being unmarried, for consideration paid, grant to  
CHARLES W. ARRAND and MYRTLE A. ARRAND, husband and wife, as joint  
 tenants  
 of Hopedale, in said County with quietus reounds

describes a certain parcel of land situated on the westerly side of  
 Millville Road, a Worcester County Highway, in said Mendon, bounded  
 (Reckoned from the south)  
 and described as follows; to wit:-

Beginning at the northeasterly corner of the granted premises  
 at a stake at remaining land of this grantor and said Millville  
 Road, which stake is twelve (12) feet northerly of a Worcester County  
 Highway bound and thirty-six and 62/100 (36.62) feet southerly of  
 the westerly side line of Taft Avenue, so called, where the same  
 joins Millville Road; thence N 79° 02' W two hundred and sixty-three  
 (263') feet, more or less, by remaining land of this grantor to a  
 stake at the shore of Lake Nipmuc; thence southerly by said Lake  
 Nipmuc one hundred and thirty-eight (138') feet, more or less, to  
 an iron pipe at land of one Wagner et ux; thence S 75° 29' E by  
 said land of Wagner et ux two hundred and fifty-one and 29/100  
 (251.29) feet to said Millville Road, a portion of said distance  
 being along a stonewall; thence N 10° 58' E one hundred and  
 fifty-nine 88/100 (159.88) feet by said Millville Road to the stake  
 at the point of beginning.

Meaning and intending to hereby convey a portion of the premises  
 conveyed to this grantor and M. Agnes Kelley by Administrator's  
 deed of Adaline A. Davenport, dated September 4, 1917 and recorded  
 in Worcester District Registry of Deeds, Book 2149, page 9.
