I give and bequeath to my well beloved Son Joseph Whee<sup>l</sup>ock 169.  
- look his heirs and assigns forever all the land I die seized &  
possessed of & the Buildings standing thereon reserving the im-  
provement of one half of all the land, as expressed in the  
bequest to my beloved Wife Priscilla Wheelock. And as to all  
the rest residue and remainder of my Personal Estate to my  
dear tenants, goods & chattels not before named in this  
Will, of what kind and nature ever, I give & bequeath  
the same to my beloved Son Joseph Wheelock.

Item-

I will and direct that my Son Joseph Wheelock pay  
all my Debts, the Legacy to my Son Benjamin Whee-  
lock, and funeral charges out of what I have devised &  
given to him by this my last Will and Testament  
in manner & time above expressed.

Item-

I do appoint my beloved Son Joseph Wheelock and  
Johnson Sogg both of the aforesaid Mendon to  
be my Executors to this my last Will and Testament,  
hereby revoking all former Wills by me made.
