Testament in a manner and form following.

posals being Money that she brought with her at my Mar-
riage.

I do also give and bequeath unto my Brothers Amr
Goodale, Paul Goodale, David Goodale & Peter Goodale together
with my Sister Elizabeth Smith, single Woman the sum
of Ten Dollars to be equally divided among them which
said several Legacies or sums of Money, I will and ordere
shall be paid to the said respective Legatees within six
months after my decease.

Lastly & of all the rest I give and bequeath unto my
beloved Wife Silence Goodale, my Testament in which
I now live with all my personal estate, Goods and
Chattels of what kind & nature soever, during her

natural life and after her decease to be equally divided among
the above named Heirs.

Also I appoint my beloved Wife Silence Goodale Exec-
utor together with Nicholas Jrks Executor of this my
last Will & Testament thereby revoking all former Wills
by me made.
