First.

I give and bequeath unto my beloved Wife Silence Goodale the sum of Sixty Dollars to be hers and after her decease, being Money that she brought with her at our Marriage.

I do also give and bequeath unto my Brothers Aram Goodale, Paul Goodale, David Goodale, & Peter Goodale together with my Sister Elizabeth Smith, single Woman the sum of Ten Dollars to be equally divided among them, which said several Legacies or sums of Money, I will and order shall be paid to the said respective Legatees within Six months after my decease. &c

Lastly & of all the rest, I give and bequeath unto my beloved Wife Silence Goodale, my Testament in which I now live with all my ^{frehold estate together with all my} personal Estate, goods, and Chattels of what kind & nature soever, during her

natural life and after her decease to be equally divided among the above named Heirs. &c

Also I appoint my beloved Wife Silence Goodale Executor together with Nicholas Jenks Executor of this my last Will & Testament. & hereby revoking all former Wills by me made. &c
