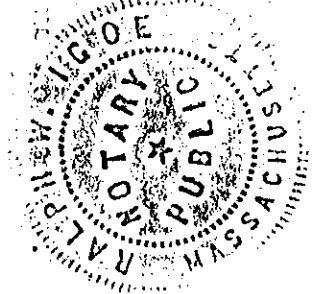

I, D. Kinsley Barnes,

of Mendon, Worcester County, Massachusetts,

~~being unmarried,~~ for consideration paid, grant to Erle W. Gaskill of said Mendon,

with *quitclaim covenants*

A certain parcel of land situated on the easterly side of Gaskill Street, in said Mendon, bounded and described as follows:

Commencing at the southwesterly corner thereof at a stone wall on the easterly side of Gaskill Street, thence northerly along the easterly side of Gaskill Street 273 feet to land of one Vincent; thence easterly along a stone wall on the southerly side of said Vincent land 250 feet to the westerly side of other land of said Vincent; thence southerly along a stone wall on the westerly side of said Vincent land 287 feet to a driveway; thence westerly along the northerly side of said driveway 236 feet to the place of beginning.

Meaning and intending to convey and hereby conveying the same and all the same premises as were conveyed to me by deed of Erle W. Gaskill, dated September 19, 1951, and recorded with Worcester District Deeds, Book 3366, Page 42.
