## OF INSTRUMENT

We, Roosevelt Mattson and Greta Maria Mattson, husband and wife, both

of Mendon, Worcester

County, Massachusetts,

being xonmorrism's for consideration paid, grant to Richard M. Mattson and Vivian C. Mattson, husband and wife, as tenants by the entirety, both of Milford, in said County of Worcester,

with Quitclaim covenants

A certain tract or parcel of land situated on the northerly side of Northbridge Road, formerly described as the road leading from Mendon to Northbridge passed the Otis Thayer place in said Mendon and being more particularly bounded and described as follows, to wit:-

Beginning at an iron pipe at the southwesterly corner of the granted premises at said road and at land of one Boulanger, formerly of one Holbrooke, which iron pipe is also 15.85 feet distant measured northeasterly along the northerly line of said road from a Worcester County Highway Bound, thence northeasterly by the northerly line of said road being a curve to the right having a radius of 719.21 feet, a distance of 179.00 feet to an iron pipe; thence N. 13° 33' 00" W., 230.00 feet to a drill hole in a stone wall; thence N. 88° 33'  $00^{11}$  W. by a stone wall 184.25 feet to a drill hole at the intersection of stone walls, the last two courses bounding on remaining land of the grantors; and thence S. 13° 33' 00" E. by a stone wall and said Boulanger land 256.45 feet to the iron pipe at the point of beginning.
