whereby Three certain parcels of land situated in said Mendon bounded

and described as follows: (Description and encumbrances, if any)

Parcel 1

Being those premises described in deed of Marcus W. Aldrich to Elbert W. Goss, dated November 1, 1900, recorded with Worcester District Deeds Book 1685, Page 436, therein bounded and described as follows:

"A certain triangular tract of land containing about one-fifth of an acre, situated in said Mendon southerly of the highway leading therefrom to Uxbridge, and bounded as follows: beginning at the southerly corner of the premises at land of Luther E. Taft and of Henry W. Gaskill, thence running N. 29 deg. E. with said Gaskill land, 122 feet, thence S. 72 deg. 10 min. W. with grantor's other land, 198.5 feet to land this day conveyed by said Taft to this grantee, thence S. 70 deg. E., about 135.5 feet with said land this day conveyed and other land of said Taft, to the point of beginning."
