the receipt whereof we do hereby acknowledge, have granted, bargained, and sold, and by these pres-  
ents do give, grant, bargain, sell, alien, enfeoff, convey, and confirm unto the said Robert Porter  
and Richard Porter

their heirs and assigns, forever, the land in Athol,  
County of Worcester, Commonwealth of Massachusetts, bounded and  
described as follows, viz:

Beginning at the north-east corner thereof at a stone  
bound in the southerly line of Euclid Street and at corner of land  
now or formerly of Lucy S. Waite; thence S. 8° 3' W. by said Waite  
land 57.08 feet to a stone bound at corner of other land of the  
grantees; thence N. 77° 20' W. by land of the grantees 50 feet to
