

M<sup>c</sup>Intire Nathan Jun. Know all men by these presents, that I Nathan M<sup>c</sup>Intire  
 to Jun. of Mendon in the County of Worcester & Commonwealth  
 Ephraim Lee - of Massachusetts Painter, in consideration of one hundred dol-  
 lars to me paid by Ephraim Lee of Mendon aforesaid Cord-  
 wainer, the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge, have re-  
 mised, released, and forever quitclaimed, and do for myself &  
 my heirs, by these presents, remise, release, and forever quitclaim  
 unto the said Ephraim Lee, his heirs and assigns, all my right  
 interest and title in and unto a certain piece of land situate  
 and being in Mendon aforesaid, containing by estimation one acre  
 and one quarter of an acre and seven square rods, be the same  
 more or less, with the building thereon; bounded as follows, to wit,  
 Westerly on land belonging to Seth Hastings, Southerly & Easterly on land belong-  
 ing to Seth Davenport & Seth Hastings & Northerly on the Turnpike road  
 or however otherwise bounded or reputed to be bounded; being the same land  
 which Benjamin Wheelock conveyed to the said M<sup>c</sup>Intire & Lee by his  
 two Deeds bearing date the twenty first day of December in <sup>the</sup> year of our  
 Lord one thousand eight hundred and seven, which Deeds are recorded  
 in the Registry of Deeds in the said County of Worcester, Book 167 Page  
 467 & 470. — To have and to hold the aforesaid premises, with all  
 the privileges and appurtenances thereunto belonging, to him the said  
 Ephraim Lee, his heirs and assigns, forever; so that neither I the said  
 Nathan M<sup>c</sup>Intire Jun., nor my heirs, or any other person or persons  
 claiming from or under me, or them, or in the name, right, or stead  
 of me or them, shall or will, by any way or means, have claim or demand  
 any right or title to the aforesaid premises, or their appurtenances, or  
 to any part or parcel thereof forever. In witness whereof I the said  
 Nathan M<sup>c</sup>Intire Jun. and — M<sup>c</sup>Intire my wife in token  
 of the relinquishment of her rights of dower or thirds in the above de-  
 scribed premises, have hereunto set our hands and seals this thirty first  
 day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred  
 and eight. —
