Jackson her heirs and assigns a certain piece of land situate and being in said Mendon containing by estimation one acre and one quarter of an acre and seven square rods be the same more or less with all the buildings thereon bounded as follows to wit westerly on land belonging to Seth Hastings southerly and easterly on land belonging to said Hastings and his children and northerly on the Turnpike Road or however otherwise bounded or reputed to be bounded — To have and to hold the aforegranted premises to the said Harriet Jackson her heirs and assigns to her and their use and behoof forever and I do for myself my heirs executors and administrators covenant with the said Harriet C. Jackson her heirs and assigns that I am lawfully seized in fee of the aforegranted premises that they are free of all incumbrances that I have good right to sell and convey the same to the said Harriet C. Jackson and that I will warrant and defend the same premises to the said Harriet C. Jackson her heirs and assigns forever against the lawful claims and demands of all persons — In witness whereof I the said Ephraim Lee and I Abby Lee wife of the said Ephraim Lee in testimony of relinquishing my right of dower to said premises have hereunto set our hands and seals this twenty ninth day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and nineteen.
