 Massachusetts wheelwright the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowl-  
 edge do hereby give grant, sell and convey unto said Moses  
 Bolcom his heirs and assigns a certain lot of land situated in  
 the Southerly part of said Douglas containing about one acre be-  
 the same more or less bounded as follows beginning at a corner of the  
 road near the schoolhouse thence running easterly by the road that  
 leads from the above named house to the Friends Meeting houses to  
 Joseph Emerson's Land thence by said Emerson Land Northerly  
 fifteen rods to a stake and stones thence westerly to the road that  
 leads from Nathan Coseville to the above mentioned named school  
 house thence by said road to the first mentioned bounds together with  
 the buildings thereon standing To have and to hold the  
 afore granted premises to the said Moses Bolcom his heirs and  
 assigns to his & their use and behoof forever. And I do for my  
 self heirs Executors and Administrators covenant with the said  
 Moses Bolcom his heirs assigns that I am lawfully seized  
 in fee of the afore granted premises that they are free of all  
 incumbrances that I have good right to sell and convey the

 have hereunto set our hands and seals this twenty ninth  
 day of March in the year of our lord one thousand eight  
 hundred & nineteen, Oliver Hunt <sup>seal</sup>
