 paid by Ruel Rawson and Jeremiah May both of said men
 don Blacksmiths the Receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge
 do hereby give, grant, sell and convey unto the said Ruel Rawson
 and Jeremiah May their Heirs and Assigns, a certain tract
 or parcel of land, containing by estimation one acre and one
 quarter of an acre, and seven square rods, be the same more
 or less, situated nearly opposite the New Meeting house in
 said Mendon, and bounded as follows, to wit, Westerly on land
 of Caleb Hayward, Southerly and easterly on land of Seth Hastings
 and Children, and Northerly on the Turnpike road or
 however otherwise bounded or reputed to be bounded, with all the
 buildings thereon standing and the appurtenances thereto be-
 longing. — To have and to hold the afore-granted Premises
 to the said Ruel Rawson and Jeremiah May in equal
 Moieties their Heirs and Assigns, to their Use and Benefit forever.
 And I do, for myself my Heirs, Executors and Administrators, co-
 erant with the said Ruel Rawson and Jeremiah May their re-
 spective Heirs and Assigns. That I am lawfully seized in fee of
 the afore-granted Premises; That they are free of all Incumbrances;
 except a Mortgage to Jonathan Russell, which I hereby agree to pay
 off and to procure the same to be discharged. That I have good Right
 to sell and convey the same to the said Ruel Rawson and Jeremiah
 May, and that I will warrant and defend the same Premises, to the
 said Ruel Rawson and Jeremiah May their respective Heirs &
 Assigns forever, against the lawful claims and demands of all
