 heirs and assigns, to his and their use and behoof forever. and we do  
 for ourselves our heirs, Executors and administrators, covenant with  
 the said Elias Rawson his heirs and assigns, that we are lawfully  
 seized in fee of the aforesigned premises; that they are free of all encu-  
 mbrances; that we have good right to sell and convey the same to  
 the said Elias Rawson and that we will warrant and defend the  
 same premises to the said Elias Rawson his heirs and assigns fore-  
 ver, against the lawful claims and demands of all persons.

- Provided nevertheless, that if the said Rueb Rawson and Jeremiah  
 May their heirs, Executors, or administrators, pay to the said Elias  
 Rawson his heirs, Executors, administrators or assigns, the sum of  
 Five hundred and fifty dollars with interest annually in two  
 years from the date hereof, and the further sum of five hundred doll-
