Know all men by these presents, that I Jeremiah May of Men-  
don in the County of Worcester and Commonwealth of Massa-  
chusetts Blacksmith in consideration of Thirteen hundred and  
fifty Dollars paid by Caleb Hayward of Mendon aforesaid  
Esquire the Receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge, do hereby  
give, grant, sell and convey unto the said Caleb Hayward his  
Heirs and Assigns, a certain tract of land, situate in said Men-  
don opposite to the New Meeting-house, with a dwelling house,  
barn, Blacksmith's shop and other buildings thereon, contain-  
ing one acre and forty two rods, and bounded as follows to wit,  
beginning at the westerly corner of the Premises, at a corner of  
the Grantee's land, thence running South  $23\frac{1}{3}$ ° East seventeen  
rods and seven links, and bounding on the said grantee's  
land, then turning and running North  $43\frac{3}{4}$ ° East twelve  
rod, then North  $42\frac{3}{4}$ ° East thirteen rods and eight links to the  
Turnpike road leading from Boston to Hartford and bounding  
on land of Seth Hastings and Children, then turning and run-  
ning South  $82\frac{3}{4}$ ° West twenty four rods and eight links to the  
first mentioned bound, and bounding northerly on said Turnpike  
road, with all the privileges and appurtenances thereto belong-  
ing. — To have and to hold the afore-mentioned Premises to  
the said Caleb Hayward his Heirs and Assigns, to his and their  
use and behoof forever. And I do, for myself my Heir, Executor  
and Administrators, covenant with the said Caleb Hayward  
his Heirs and Assigns, that I am lawfully seized in fee of the  
afore-mentioned Premises, that they are free of all Incumbrances,  
except a Mortgage, made by Elias Rawson to Jonathan Russell  
which I hereby promise to cause to be paid and discharged —  
Also another Mortgage made by me and Ruel Rawson to  
Elias Rawson dated April 1<sup>st</sup> 1825. which the said Hayward is  
to pay, and the amount now due thereon to be deducted from  
the consideration of this deed, that I have good Right to sell and  
convey the same to the said Caleb Hayward, and that I will  
warrant and defend the same Premises to the said Caleb  
Hayward his Heirs and Assigns forever, against the lawful  
Claims and demands of all persons, except the last mentioned  
Mortgage made to the said Elias Rawson. — In witness where-
