Staples of said Mendon bootmaker the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge do give grant poll and convey unto the said Alvand T. Staples his heirs and assigns a certain tract of land in said Mendon situated near the first parish meeting house in said Mendon bounded and described as follows, viz: beginning at the northwest corner on the south side of road leading from Mendon to Uxbridge at a spike driven into the fence thence south with the fence 5 rods 10 links to the northwesterly corner of the barn thence south 8 rods 6 links to the center of the wall at land of Charles C. P. Hastings and Mary M. Hayward thence turning easterly with the centre of the wall as it now stands 9 rods 7 links to a corner thence turning northwesterly by said Hastings and Hayward's land 10 rods 11 links to the northeasterly corner at the road thence westerly by the south side of the road 9 rods 13 links to the point of beginning containing about $\frac{5}{8}$ of an acre with all the buildings standing on said land together with all the privileges and appurtenances to the said land in any wise appertaining and belonging. Possession to be had on the first day of April A.D. 1848. To have and to hold the aforesaid premises to the said Staples his heirs and assigns to him and their use and behoof forever.
