I know all men by these presents that I Charles D. Wood of Worcester in the County of Worcester and Commonwealth of Massachusetts Gentleman - in consideration of one hundred and fifty six dollars paid by Perry Wood of Mendon in said County of Worcester Yeoman - the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge do give grant sell and convey unto the said Perry Wood his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of land situated in the westerly part of said Mendon in said County containing by estimation thirteen acres and eighteen rods the same more or less bounded as follows - to wit - Beginning at the southwesterly corner of the premises at land of Madiah Wood or otherwise Perry Wood on the north side of the Old Hartford Turnpike so called thence north  $14^{\circ}$  west bounding westerly by land of said Perry Wood 9 rods  $12\frac{1}{2}$  links thence north  $25^{\circ}$  west bounding westerly on land of said Perry Wood  $45\frac{3}{4}$  rods to an oak with stones thence north  $86^{\circ}$  east bounding northerly by land of the grantor 34 rods  $12\frac{1}{2}$  links to stake & stones thence south  $3^{\circ}$  east bounding easterly by land of Luke Aldrich 51 rods to the turnpike aforesaid thence turning and running westerly bounding southerly on said turnpike to the point of beginning - And the said Charles D. Wood reserves to himself his heirs and assigns forever the right of passing over the above described premises to and from the said turnpike from and to his wood lot northerly of and adjoining the aforesaid premises - To have and to hold the aforesaid premises to the said Perry Wood his heirs and assigns to his and their use and behoof forever - And I do for myself my
