And we do covenant to warrant and defend said granted and quit-claimed premises to the said Nancy F. White, and her heirs and assigns forever, against the lawful claims and demands of all persons claiming by or under us. And I, Nellie C. White, wife of the said Edward R. White, for the consideration aforesaid, do hereby release and quit-claim unto the said Nancy F. White, and her heirs and assigns, all the right, title, claim, or demand which I may have in and unto the premises hereby conveyed, under or by virtue of the Homestead-Exemption Laws of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, and also all right, claim, or possibility of dower in said premises.
