Taft, of Blackstone, Worcester Co., Massachusetts, of the second part, Witnesseth, That the said parties of the first part, in the consideration of the sum of two hundred twenty five dollars, to them in hand paid, by said party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby confessed and acknowledged, have bargained, sold, remised and quitclaimed, and by these presents do bargain, sell, remise and quitclaim unto the said party of the second part, and to his heirs and assigns forever, All that tract, or parcel of land situate in the Towns of Mendon & Blackstone, County of Worcester and State of Massachusetts, Bounded & described as follows. All that tract or parcel of land situate in the Southeasterly part of Mendon & North-erly part of Blackstone in the State of Massachusetts. Contain- ing one Hundred & fourteen acres, be the same more or less, with Saw Mills & Shingle Mill & all machinery therein, it being wood land belonging to Arnold Taft, late of Mendon, dec'd. And this grant conveys all the right, title & interest of the said George A. Greene, and Annah S. Greene, his wife, in, of, or to said land that they now have, or may have by virtue of being heirs at law of said Arnold Taft, deceased, Excepting & reserving therefrom so much of said premises as were conveyed to Geo.
