Taft Martha Wc. Know all men by these presents, that we, Martha W.
 to Taft, widow, and Betsey W. Southwick, wife of Andre Southwick,
 Lewis W. Taft all of Mendon, in the County of Worcester and Commonwealth
 of Massachusetts, and Jane E. Alexander, of Webster in said
 County, widow, in consideration of eight hundred dollars (\$800,
 paid by Lewis W. Taft, of Blackstone, in said County, the re-
 ceipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby remise, re-
 lease, and forever quitclaim unto the said Lewis W. Taft,
 A certain tract of land situated partly in the Southerly part
 of Mendon aforesaid, and partly in the Northerly part of
 Blackstone aforesaid, containing one hundred and fourteen
 (114) acres, more or less, together with the buildings thereon,
 including a Saw Mill and Shingle Mill, and all the ma-
 chinery in and appertaining thereto, and all the papers con-
 cerning said land, including a certain plat thereof, mean-
 ing hereby to quitclaim all our right, title and interest in
 and to the land, called the Saw Mill Wood Lot of which Ar-
 nold Taft, deceased, late of Mendon aforesaid, died seized
 and possessed, the said lot being a part of the estate of said
 Arnold Taft at the time of his decease. To have and to
 hold the granted premises, with all the privileges and ap-
 pertenances thereto belonging, to the said Lewis W. Taft
 and his heirs and assigns, to their own use and behoof
 forever. And we do hereby, for ourselves, and our heirs, execu-
 tors and administrators, covenant with the said grantee and
 his heirs and assigns that the granted premises are free from
 all incumbrances made or suffered by us, and that we
 will, and our heirs, executors, and administrators shall
 warrant and defend the same to the said grantee and
 his heirs and assigns forever against the lawful claims
 and demands of all persons claiming by, through, or un-
 der us, but against none other. In witness whereof,
